Severe Weather Policy

1. Relating to Sunday Services

- a. In the event of a severe thunderstorm warning, tornado watch or warning, winter storm warning, or hazardous driving conditions, the Elders may cancel a service. **Cancellation/postponement decisions will be made no later than 8pm on Saturday night.**
- b. If the Elders decide to cancel/postpone a Sunday service, no ministries will take place on that Sunday (Fellowship Kids, Whiteboard classes, service, etc). No Elder or ministry leader will be present at the church and the doors will remain locked.
- c. If a service is canceled/postponed, communication will immediately happen in the following ways:
 - i. All ministry leaders called:
 1. Children's Ministries: Mark Gilmour
 2. Whiteboard teachers: Scott Foreman
 3. Facilities: Scott Foreman
 4. Tech/Music: Justin Carlton
 - ii. Cancellation/postponement will be posted on FBC Facebook page, tweeted and posted on website.
 - iii. An email will be sent to our general email list.
 - iv. Seniors who may not have access to electronic media will be called.

2. Relating to Ministries During the Week/Concerts and Events:

- a. In the event of a severe thunderstorm warning, tornado watch or warning, winter storm warning, or hazardous driving conditions, the Executive Pastor may cancel a ministry happening at the church (a decision will be made no later than 4pm). **Cancellation/postponement decisions will be made in consultation with other Elders and ministry leaders.**
- b. If a service is canceled/postponed, communication will immediately happen in the following ways:
 - i. All pertinent ministry leaders called (Executive Pastor/Office Administrator)
 - ii. Cancellation/postponement will be posted on FBC Facebook page, tweeted and posted on website.
 - iii. An email will be sent to our general email list.
- c. Seniors who may not have access to electronic media will be called.
